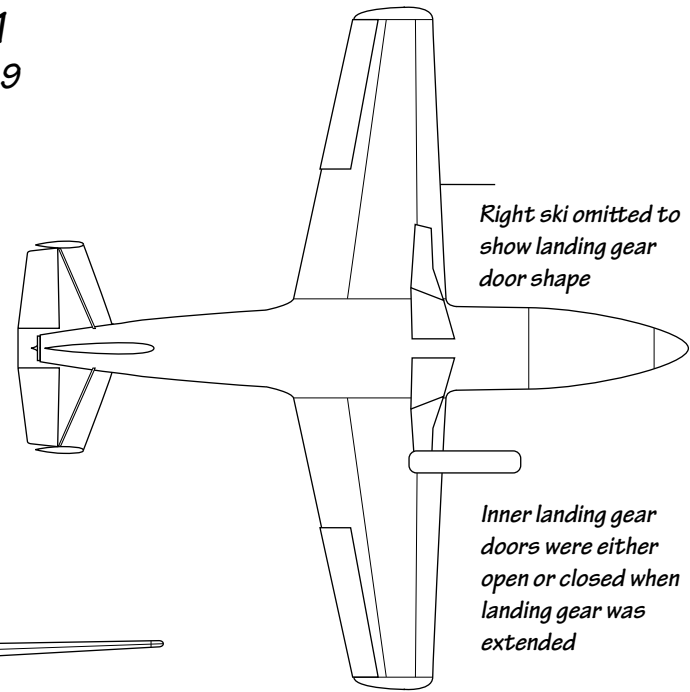
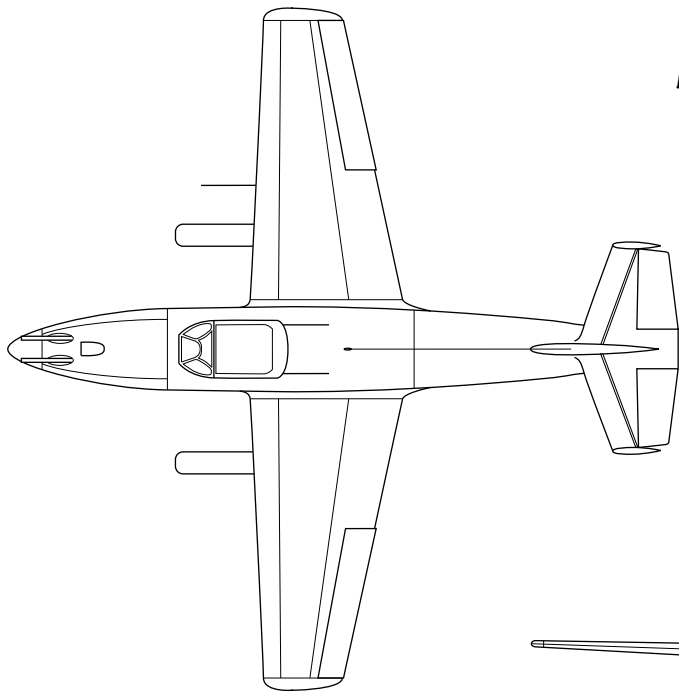
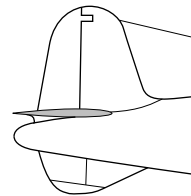
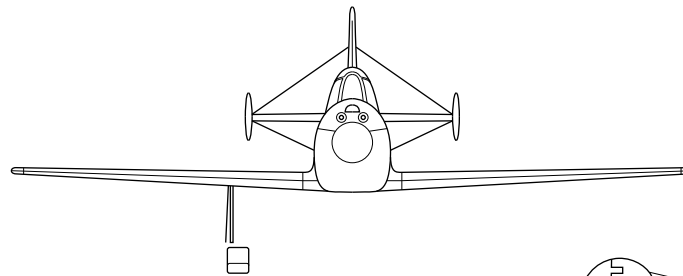

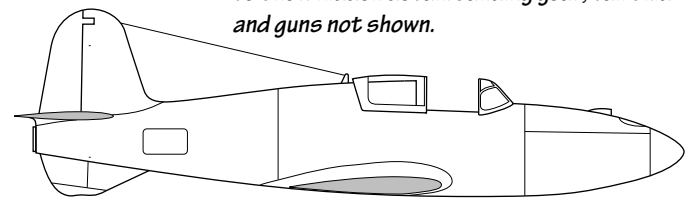
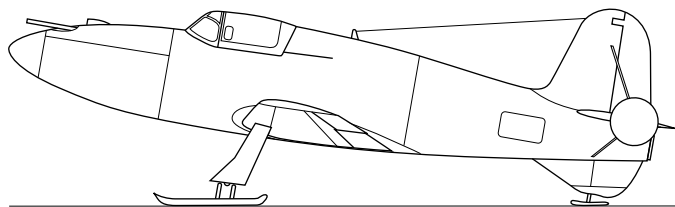
Right ski omitted to show landing gear door shape
